Information We May Collect About You

Any information that we collect via *HOIHA.org* will be used to improve the content of the website and advance the Association's mission. For each visitor to our website, our web server automatically recognizes only the user's domain name, but not the e-mail address. We collect:

- Domain name and Internet protocol (IP) address of each visitor to our site
- Aggregate information on what pages users access or visit
- User-specific information on what pages users access or visit
- Information volunteered by users, including surveys, purchases, and/or registrations
- E-mail addresses of those who communicate with us by e-mail

We use cookies to administer our website and record session information.

Use of Information Collected

HOIHA may use your contact information to alert you to new information, products and services, special events, and other items of interest. We will not sell or give your e-mail address to any entity outside HOIHA.

User Rights

In order to respect your privacy, you at any time may exercise your rights to privacy by contacting HOIHA.
